

## FIREARMS PERMIT AMMUNITION COLLECTION AUTHORITY AND CONDITIONS

Firearm types which apply: Ammunition Only

## **Authority**

This permit authorises the permit holder to acquire and possess ammunition for the purposes of an ammunition collection only.

The authority conferred by this permit is subject to the *Firearms Act 1996* and the associated Regulation and all the General Legislative Requirements applicable to a firearm permit holder<sup>1</sup> apply to this permit in addition to the conditions outlined below.

## **Conditions:**

- 1. The permit holder must ensure that the ammunition forming part of the collection is stored in a locked container, locked display case or other locked cabinet which is sturdy in construction and not easily penetrated.
- 2. The permit holder must ensure that any ammunition forming part of the collection is rendered inert (other than any sporting or military ammunition of *UN Hazard Classification Code 1.4.S* up to 20 mm calibre).
- 3. Any ammunition collected must not contain high explosive, smoke, chemical or lachrymatory properties or agents.
- 4. The permit holder must not supply ammunition unless the other person is authorised to possess that type of ammunition by way of a licence or permit and that authorisation has been sighted by the permit holder.
- 5. The permit holder must not acquire ammunition unless the supplier is authorised to possess that type of ammunition by way of a licence or permit and that authorisation has been sighted by the permit holder.
