1. Opening and Welcome.

The meeting was opened at 6.35pm by **S/Constable Rollinson** who welcomed everyone and introduced **A/Insp Glenn Smith** who is currently acting in Insp Bell role.

2. Amendments and acceptance of previous meetings.

Amendments:

There was one amendment to the minutes, in her absence Julie Burgess had asked that the community issue regarding the bus shelter at Roseville Chase. The minutes read “all the kids are standing on the road...” they should have read “all the kids are standing on the kerb...”.

3. Community Police Briefing – Local Crime Priorities

S/Cst Rollinson presented the maps and crime trends while **I/Insp Smith** provided an overview of recent crime trends and Police activity since the last meeting.

Supt Critchlow lead a detailed discussion about synthetic d rugs and the role they have played in the recent death of a 17 year old North Shore teen. **Supt Critchlow** also provided information regarding legislation and the impact of synthetic drugs on the community.

Supt Critchlow again reinforced the value of our strong relationship with Westfields Security and the Mandarin Centre and discussed his attempts to build a strong relationship with Chatswood Chase Security.

Supt Critchlow provided an update on the progress of a community issue raised at the previous meeting regarding traffic concerns in Lane Cove. **Supt Critchlow** has met with **Mayor Bennison**, together they have arranged to have a regular meeting incorporating Police, Council and RMS to work towards improving the situation.

Supt Critchlow informed the group that at a Police level he is in the process of designing a protocol for responding to incidents on arterial roads- a rapid response to getting roads clear.

In discussing local crime **Supt Critchlow** stated that he has driven pro activity which has led to a reduction in crime. Pro activity allows Police to get to know the criminals and prevent crimes from occurring. Our legal action rates are up and victim follow up is 97%, the highest in the state.

Supt Critchlow asked for suggestion for Facebook as North Shore LAC looks towards humanising Facebook. He asked for community members to submit photos from community engagements etc.

A/Insp Smith asked the group to notify police of any community engagements so that Police could attend.

Supt Critchlow informed the group that this meeting will be **S/Constable Rollinson's** last meeting and that S/Constable **Sascha Orrock** will commence in the role 16th June 2013.

4. Community Issues / Outcome

ISSUE	ACTION / OUTCOME
Ian St Vincent: The crossing guard at Lindfield Primary School has expressed concerns re a push bike riding across the crossing, ducking in and out of pedestrians. This is an older person and he is becoming abusive. Sgt Marks is aware of this.	Supt Critchlow: I will speak to Sgt Marks about it.
Ian St Vincent: I spoke to Ku Ring Gai Council Rangers about Little Creek Bushland from Milray St to Nelson St Lindfield. Someone is dumping rubbish. It looks like residential rubbish, mattresses etc.	Supt Critchlow: This is not actually a police matter, it is the responsibility of local Council. We are always happy to hear about it and help where we can however it is Council responsibility.

Ian St Vincent: There is a HWP Motor Cycle rider who rides down Grosvenor St, Lindfield about 4.20pm almost daily, he rides past people parking illegally and does not stop to issue any tickets.	Supt Critchlow: I will find out who it is and speak to them and make sure they are doing what they are supposed to be doing.
Ian St Vincent: Just a thanks, we had an exposure job near the school. It just happened that police were driving past at the right time.	Supt Critchlow: It was good timing.
Leah Bangma: We are also having problems with rubbish dumping at Stringy Bark Creek. There is a building site and the rubbish is building material. I have spoken to the site foreman about it.	Supt Critchlow: Again it is the responsibility of Council.
Erica Wallace: There is a motor cycle shop on Epping Rd on the corner of Centennial Ave, Lane Cove. They are using Coolah Pde to test drive the motor cycles. They are riding fast and it is dangerous. I have spoken to the owner who says it is not his staff but it is because they are wearing clothes with the shop logo on it.	Supt Critchlow: I will speak to Sgt Marks and Highway Patrol about it.
Reg Muir: I was just wondering has there been any response to the request for youth support.	Supt Critchlow: Not that we are away of. I would have to confirm with S/Constable Hurly is the Youth Liaison Officer.
