Big problem that we have had is SFMV in Batemans Bay and a week and half ago locked up a man for SFMV and this crime has reduced. Released from a Victorian prison and had an ACT address.</p> <p>HWP are really active in doing what they need to do on the Princes and Kings Hwy. Discussion in regards to reasons why and driving to conditions of the road and weather. Comment Andrew Constance in regards to Princes Hwy and Minister for Roads and Transport. Discussion in regards to Road Safety Officer and the need for one at Bega. Comment Insp Abbott, and discussion with RTA and funded half, half.</p> <p>Andrew Constance – comment in regards to roads and the issue of Accident Investigation Unit and we have relied on Warilla and now local Detectives to investigate. We need the minister to allocate funds within the Command. Insp Megay, explained that the nature and circumstances of the collision in the Moruya incident were unusual as the decedent's location was particularly crucial for the investigators to analyse and determine point of collision; Normally a decedent would not remain in-situ for such a lengthy time. Discussion in regards to diverting traffic.</p> <p>Insp Megay – good news is the Police are active in identifying criminals locking up crooks and doing what is needed to be done in responding to emergencies and preventing crime.</p>
