Discussion Item

- *Mentioned that there has been an increase of activity in the main street*
- *New magistrate has commenced and there has been some good results/outcomes*
- *Copy of an MOU for a Development Application given to council for review (Police and Council)*
- *CCTV discussed and community are now in support of the project. Council facilities are now covered with CCTV*
- *Drug testing was discussed. Committee informed that General duties police do not have the legislation just to test any person on the street for drugs.*
- *It was asked if we were able to capture crime statistics on crime caused by people drug affected etc. Det Insp GREENTREE stated it is not easy to capture this information exactly.*
- *Mentioned that there was no staff member rostered on a Sunday night shift. There was reassurance that police will be rostered on, and that there is now new police rostered in Brewarrina*
- *Underage youth drinking discussed. Are we able to find out who is supplying these kids the alcohol. Police stated that we rely on the community support to supply us with the information required to take appropriate action.*
