Recommendation 231 of the Royal Commission into Aboriginal Deaths in Custody Report: *Police Services to actively pursue improvements in its relationship with Aboriginal people - Different jurisdiction pursue their chosen initiatives for improving relations between police and Aboriginal people in the form of police aides, police liaison officers and in other ways; experimenting and adjusting in the light of the experience of other services and applying what seems to work best in particular circumstances.*

Purpose of the Position

The Aboriginal Community Liaison Officer (ACLO) is as a member of the Local Area Command, Crime Management Team with the responsibility for providing advice and support to Police in the management of Aboriginal issues across the Local Area Command (LAC).

ACLOs assists in developing, implementing, monitoring and reviewing programs that bring about positive outcomes between Police and Aboriginal people and which are in line with NSW Police policy.

The ACLO works closely with the Aboriginal community, Aboriginal community organisations and other service providers in their day to day activities.

The ACLO promotes an awareness of NSW Police to Aboriginal people and communities and promotes an awareness of Aboriginal issues to Police.

Key Areas:

- ✦ Promote an awareness of the functions of NSW Police within the Aboriginal community.
- ✦ Identify barriers that prevent open communication and consultation between Aboriginal people and Police.
- ✦ Foster mutual understanding between Police and Aboriginal communities.
- ✦ Encourage Aboriginal people to discuss with Police, issues surrounding crime and violence in the Aboriginal community.
- ✦ Encourage Aboriginal communities to work with Police in developing programs that overcome Aboriginal disadvantage as it relates to a policing environment.
- ✦ Provide a link between Police and the Aboriginal community through the application of the NSW Police Aboriginal Strategic Direction.
- ✦ Provide a link between Police and the Aboriginal community through the establishment of the Local Area Command Aboriginal Consultative Committees.
