He Stated that police will continue to be proactive as well as educate the local community in road safety awareness particularly the elderly members of the community. He also discussed the issue of safety in school zones and public education and awareness aimed at improving school zone safety.</p> <p>Sgt Micallef then gave an overview of Traffic/Highway Operations currently running including, TASSOAR, OBEDIENCE, SLOWDOWN and COMPLIANCE. The MCLO program was mentioned as an example developed under the former MPSP known as Ethnic Affairs Priorities Statement (EAPS). Ms. Juliana Nkrumah, the Statewide MCLO Coordinator also attended the meeting to show support of the MCLO Program and the MCLO in the local MPSP planning.
