CAPP Presentation

Supt Lennon also introduced a program called Community Awareness of Policing Program (CAPP). He encouraged community leaders from the Fairfield area to take up the program.

Participants will spend six evenings in Sydney and a day at our police college in Goulburn learning about and participating in elements of policing never before experienced by members of the general public including:

- The Public Order & Riot Squad
- Marine Area Command
- Tactical Operations Unit
- Counter Terrorism & Special Tactics
- Education & Training Command
- State Crime Command
- Forensic Services Group
- Police Prosecutions.

Participants will also see and take part in aspects of weapons and officer survival training. They will interact with police from these commands, from constables to commanders, and through realistic exercises be put in the shoes of these officers as they respond to public order incidents, investigate crime scenes, direct maritime search and rescue missions and face armed offenders. In return, these leaders will be encouraged to pass on to members of their communities word of what they've seen, heard and done.

Crime and Safety Issues.

- Claudia expressed concern that a number of car plates were being stolen. Claudia suggested reviving Operation TABELLA.
- Tony informed that it had been brought to his attention that a number of people who appear to be drug affected are seen wondering Fairfield. This is a result of seeing disorderly behaviour and people sleeping on park benches.
- Tony also requested Police assist him in identifying “dark spots” within Fairfield by taking a late night walk around the local area.
- Tony also presented interchange plans which need to be commented on by Police.
- Discussion was generated around Café’s within Fairfield. All agree that no issues have come under notice recently.
