The role of the School Liaison Police (SLP) is to 'Increase the positive relationships and remove barriers between the school community and police'. This will be achieved through the implementation of programs and strategies to reduce the incidence of crime and anti-social behaviour amongst youth by developing programs and activities that involve students understanding the law, police role and their responsibilities to the community.

School Liaison Police are here to work with you and your school community to address issues that may be of particular interest to your school as well as general issues relating to incidence of crime that are taking place in the local and school community.

We are here to create, develop and strengthen relationships with the students in your school. In many ways the School Liaison Police will be the public face of the NSW Police in schools within NSW. The SLP will deliver crime prevention workshops and other educational programs in conjunction with the school to raise awareness and prevent crime. One of our aims is to reduce the number of school aged children from being victims of crime.
