AGENDA ITEM 1 & 2 – Discussed by Superintendent Philip Rogerson

- Chairperson welcomed everyone on the meeting
- The minutes were accepted as a true and accurate record of the meeting and are to be posted on the intranet for the information of NSW Police personnel
- Resources issues discussed:
 - 27 new probationary constables. Doing well – now 2 up
 - 3 new sergeants starting on the 15th May
 - Around 2 vacancies in Sergeant positions
 - Highway vacancy positions possibly 2
 - Inspectors 1 vacancy has been nominated and background checks etc being finalised
 - Mr Whyte moving on to the gang squad 19/06. Crime manager position becoming vacant but will be picked up straight away via the promotion list
 - Currently over strength due to new Constables
 - Crime targets met. Targets met as of the 30/03 except assaults and steal from person. Coming mainly from events like the Easter Show
 - Arrests at 150 + per month across the board. A significant number of bail refused. Pro activity close to highest in the state
 - Security upgrades are going to happen at the front counter of station area
 - CCTV throughout the entire station is being replaced and upgraded to digital

- Easter Show - crime bus located At Lidcombe reduced crime significantly to previous years
- Commuter Crime moving to old Greyhound Club located at Lidcombe adjacent to Tooheys Lane Carpark
- Day and night patrols performed on Indian Temple Cumberland Rd Auburn
