1. Meeting opened at The Hills Shire Council Chambers at 6.10pm				
Welcome from Acting Commander Wayne MURRAY from The Hills Local Area Command

4. Matters arising from last meeting:				
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An increased security presence and CCTV at Balcombe Heights Reserve on Friday and Saturday nights has decreased incidents of anti-social behaviour. However, anti-social behaviour is now occurring at the rear of the estate. Security presence organised by Baulkham Hills Shire Council will be continued on Friday and Saturday nights. 				
5. Crime Report				
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A general discussion was also held on the crime statistics – presentation delivered to the meeting by Acting Commander Wayne MURRAY on current crime trends. 2. Acting Commander MURRAY discussed how police taskings have been guided by the information gleaned from previous meetings regarding hot spots for anti-social behaviour, malicious damage and drug use etc. 				
6. General Business:				
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Information received from Tony HAY that there has been problems with anti-social behaviour at Coolong Reserve in Castle Hill involving youth and alcohol and graffiti. Local residents have observed youth carrying backpacks and consuming alcohol at the location on Friday and Saturday nights. There have been numerous complaints from residents who have requested that extra police patrols be conducted of the Coolong Reserve. The particulars of the residents are to be obtained and Intel informed of this to task crews to conduct extra patrols of Coolong Reserve on Friday and Saturday nights. 2. Information received from Jenny TISDELL that there is a large amount of graffiti (caused by graffiti pens) around the building situated at 390 Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills. Access to this building is from Conie Avenue. The graffiti has been cleaned by the council but it does occur regularly. There is also a lot of alcohol consumption later in the afternoon in the car-park of this location. Jenny TISDELL is looking at providing programs for disadvantaged families in the area. 				

3. Bashir SUMAR stated that the Bushcare Program went very well with good groups of young people in attendance. Stated that there is a Friendship Group in existence, which is a support group for all aged women who are new to Australia and who may feel depressed, etc. Bashir SUMAR also stated that there were problems with motorcyclist riders driving through Milford Park Rouse Hill along the grass and walkways. They appear to be juveniles.
4. Peter DIMBROWSKY raised that at the rear of 390A Old Northern Road, Castle Hill there have been problems with underage drinking and drug use. Young persons have been seen to loiter at this location (at times 20-30 persons have been seen) usually on Friday and Saturday nights. There is an alleyway at this location that leads to a car-park.
5. Tony HAY states that there are several young persons dressed up as "Goths" loitering at the old cemetery situated on Cecil Avenue (eastern side of Old Northern Road), Castle Hill.

8. Information from Peter DIMBROWSKY that there are anti-social behaviour problems with teens at the rear of 390 A Old Northern Road on Friday and Saturday nights.	Intel informed and car crews to be tasked to patrol the location.
9. Information from Bashir SUMAR that there are juvenile motorcyclists riding along the grass and walkways along Milford Park Rouse Hill.	Intel informed and car crews to conduct regular patrols in the afternoon.
