Overview of statistical data by Detective Inspector Brett Greentree for Warren Shire Council in comparison with other Darling River LGA's for the period.

Discussion Item

Welcome by Detective Inspector Greentree.

- *Liquor Accord – meets next in May, 2010 – discussion in relation to banning notices from licenced premises*
- *Warren bulldogs – Helping with promoting 'Stop domestic violence'. Darling River helping to support the team with providing funds from the ASD money allocated*
- *General Manager given copy of an MOU for Development applications (police and council)*
- *Staff shortages discussed and praise given to Sgt Horsington and his team. Vacant jobs have recently been advertised. Currently have officers have the northern sectors covering shortages. Authorised strength of staff has increased from 5 to 6 officers*
- *Youth sub committee – 2 meetings held thus far. Meetings held every month. Local youth surveyed as to what they wanted (targeted younger generation). Things that came back were: skate park. Currently looking at funding. 20 people in attendance for last meeting. Next youth meeting will be held on 29th April, 2010 at 10am*
- *ACLO from Orana LAC has not been seen in town recently. Mentioned that there are ACLO shortages in Dubbo. There has been negative feedback from locals due to the ACLO being related to problem local families in town*
- *Mentioned that local youth do not wish to use the youth centre, due to its location in town*
- *New School Liaison Officer (SLP) – S/Cst Stephanie Franklin – she will be based at Nyngan Police Station*
- *Last movie night held in town late 2009, 80 kids in attendance*
- *School meeting in relation to suspensions will be held in May, 2010. There is a proposal that there will be a walk done in town looking for truant kids, with a list compiled and sent to local police for follow-up. Also looking at the kids that are on suspension from school to have them placed in a separate class instead of sending them home and wandering the streets. Looking at linking up with Elders to assist with the program (mentor). A suggestion was made to ring the Principal of Nyngan*

High (Chad) as they have a similar program currently running. Mentioned that the Dept of Education have there own truancy officers, and you should tap into their resources to assist

- *Problem tenants – One of the problem families have been moved out of town, due to liaising with Dept of Eduction from Police and Council*
- *Local Football games – there is currently a group of kids trashing the toilet facilities during the game. Sgt Horsington has been given all future dates for these games, to assist with HVP. This will depend on staff numbers*
- *The community wanted feedback in relation to response times and procedures for callouts. Sgt Horsington stated that Warren Police are responding to jobs regardless of staff numbers. Police will attend jobs after hours if the victim requires or asks to see police. Police will be called out.*
