Chifley Commander Report:

Superintendent Robinson introduced presentation and advised that a discussion could take place regarding trends across the Command.

Power point presentation showing the trends across the Command. Crime is generally on a downward trend. Steal motor vehicles down and Break and enters to residential /non residential down. Offenders from other LAC's monitored through intelligence.

Graffiti in the Oberon LGA high due to several incidents occurring during a 1 night rampage.

This presentation was also broken down into Lithgow, Bathurst, Oberon and Blayney statistics and trends to show the comparison across the Command.

Bathurst has the highest rate of recorded incidents across the Command.

CCTV in Bathurst.

Some discussion was held in regards to CCTV. particularly in Machattie Park, Heritage Park and Redmond Oval. Cost effectiveness, evidentiary benefits, and the administration of the systems all discussed. Councils are giving thought to installing CCTV in strategic locations. Implementation of CCTV a decision for Councils to make.

Highway Vehicles.

1 x highway vehicle has been installed with vehicle recognition facilities which allow data regarding the status of vehicle registration and other information to be readily available to the highway officer. Vehicle is being used extensively in the Chifley LAC.

Completed monthly and forwarded to Council Representatives. .

Keith Sullivan queried the amount of DOH properties in Oberon and asked why DOH sending their clientele to Oberon. No persons from DOH at this meeting to address this issue. Mr Robinson advised several DOH properties across the command and not just in Oberon.
