

FIREARMS PERMIT PISTOL AUTHORITY AND CONDITIONS

Firearm types which apply: Category H Pistols

Authority

This permit authorises the permit holder to possess and use a pistol for the purpose of undertaking hunting (including the control or suppression of vermin or pest animals), fishing, farming and grazing activities (including the destruction of diseased or injured animals) on land owned, leased or managed by the permit holder.

The authority conferred by this permit is subject to the *Firearms Act 1996* and the Regulations and all the General Legislative Requirements applicable to a firearm permit holder¹ apply to this permit in addition to the conditions outlined below.

Conditions:

- 1. Firearms authorised by this permit must be stored in compliance with the safe storage requirements prescribed by section 41 of the *Firearms Act 1996*².
- 2. The permit holder is not authorised to possess or use firearms or ammunition for any purpose other than that set out in the authority above.
- 3. The permit holder must notify the Commissioner if the medical condition or disability that prevents the permit holder from using a rifle or shotgun changes or is no longer present or applicable.
