## Community Police Briefing – Local Crime Priorities

### S/Con Jewell

- Provided the group with a briefing and discussion of the current crime maps / trends.
- Maps showed marginal rise in Break and Enter offences since the last meeting, however levels have still remained low compared to normal averages.

### Insp Bell:

- Briefed meeting recent arrest of offenders caught trying to steal a yacht in Tamborine Bay. Arrest came after nearby residents alerted Police to suspicious noises coming from the yacht. Shows the importance of timely calls to the Police.
- Recent Compass Review went well for the North Shore LAC – Stats very good, particularly Break and Enters, which were 268 under target.
- Analysis of Malicious Damage stats for the last 12 months showed that the bulk of these offences are “Malicious Damage to Property (687) rather than Graffiti (146) This is contrary to the sometimes common view that graffiti accounts for the bulk of damage offences.

- A large number of additional Police are being rostered for New Years Eve duties. As per previous years, crews will be present in Greenwich and Longueville to ensure the night is celebrated appropriately.

### **Community Issues / Outcome**

<b>ISSUE</b>	<b>ACTION / OUTCOME</b>
Michael Haine – enquired about the area within the LAC with the most alcohol driven crime	Insp Bell replied that Alcohol related crime is very low here. Police rank licensed premises as Group 1, 2 or 3 based on crime levels. (Group 1 highest) There are no Group 1 or 2 premises within the LAC
Tiu Kroll Simmul – reported that the local ‘Smart Dollar’ store in Victoria Ave Chatswood is selling novelty toys shaped as male and female genitalia.	Insp Bell to investigate the nature and legality of these products
Debbie Hutchens - Reported that there is a frequent issue with people drinking in the street / gutter opposite Porters Liquor store on Kenneth Street Longueville. (adjacent to the Longueville Sporting Club.) There are also frequent issues with Malicious Damage incidents in the area	The Licensing Officer is to be advised re issues relating to the sale of alcohol. Car crews also to be tasked to patrol the area.
