Jonathan O'Dea – Are clear up rates being tracked? Mr Kenny Yes they are tracked and are part of Compass. (Compass explained further)

Mr Kenny Kuring gai will be getting 18 new Probationary Constables quickly explains buddy system and 2IC after 6 weeks with a buddy.

General Business

Mick Gallagher: Mal Damage Paint on Cars at Mt Colah (Oxley drive) questioned why PAL would not take a report from non owner. (Supt Kenny) PAL should have advised witness to call Hornsby Police who can then attend location etc. Insp Higgins to speak to MG out of sessions.

Supt Kenny: Asked if any NHW groups link up and discuss issues. Explained Tweed Byron links up and contact local MP's etc. MG Mt Colah NHW links to all Government and non government agencies and to Berowra Bush Tele. Mr Kenny NHW to continue at CSPC.

Tony Bray: S/C Formston and Comber have been our local reps for years past with a significant police presence. Launch Brooklyn has had a dredging issue and has been on the agenda for years now. The influx of thousands to the area has put a strain on other services Police have been sighted but we want more patrols. There is frustration at the Mal Dam spikes in the area with no convictions. Monday mornings mean we have to clean up the area. The problem is generally at 1am Saturday mornings in Berowra most likely local kids.

Mathild Kearny-Kibble: The Bridge to Bridge Ski race is on this Sunday. It is possible the launch could get beached on the mud. If necessary the local rescue have offered their boat if needed.

Bob Browne: Speeding in Brooklyn (Mr Kenny & Sgt Ford) to advise KU HWP. Will continue to monitor same. Sgt Ford will liaise and co-ordinate a strategy.

Jonathan O'Dea: Lindfield Tennis courts and West Lindfield has problems advised it is a Chatswood issue and to raise it with Chatswood..

St Ives update KIDS programs from KMC are running as is the development of the Village Green.

Dimas Munte: There are youths loitering and under aged drinking around Berowra RWS. The new car park is going well. Also concerns about the robbery at the Hornsby RWS advised of the arrest and charging of POI's.

Supt Kenny Explains some of the technology available to police and offers to show committee at future CSPC meetings.

Julia Eagles NHW website now negotiating with Abbotsleigh Girls HS to implement this as a an IT course project for students.
