Facebook can contribute to groups of uncontrolled youths. Nearest PCYC is Mt Druitt. Inspector Nelson advised that small problem groups are being targeted and redirected. Mr. Jarmin stated that the Police have done a good job and there had been a huge improvement in response times. Mr. De Paoli stated that we need to focus more resources on splinter groups-programs for boys. Ms Markus advised that Eagleraps engage young people who are disengaged to offer training, employment etc.</p> <p>6.2 Crime Report Presentation – Det.
