Minutes

1. Meeting opened at The Hills Shire Council Chambers at 11.15am

Welcome from Commander Supt. Sue WAITES from The Hills Local Area Command

2. Apologies:

Mayor - Mike THOMAS, Gordon ALLEN, Faye HANSEN, Bashir SUMAR, John HAYMAN, Robyn BAIRD & Des MILLIGAN.

4. Matters arising from last meeting:

1. Safety initiatives from the Liquor Accord. Leon COLOSIMO to discuss the Accord's safety strategies and initiatives – carried over to next meeting
2. Council compliance statistics for dog attacks and graffiti (locations, incidents etc). Presentation given by Charles MEADER on dog attacks. 33 dog attacks last quarter – 15 human, 18 animal. Presentation on graffiti statistics carried over to the next meeting.

5. Crime Report

1. A general discussion was also held on the crime statistics – presentation delivered to the meeting by Crime Manager, Detective Chief Inspector Wayne MURRAY, on current crime trends.

6. General Business:

1. Bashir SUMAR raised via email the instance of ongoing anti-social behaviour at Rouse Hill Town Centre. General discussion held amongst committee members. Few actual violent offences have been reported to police recently. Police tasked on an ongoing basis to patrol the location. Foot patrols of the food court and fountain area to be included in taskings.
2. Community impact of proposed Dan Murphy's liquor store on Cecil Avenue at Castle Hill raised by Tony HAY. Possibility of implementation of an alcohol free zone to be discussed with Council and Police next week.
3. Tony HAY requested patrols of old Cemetery attached to Church on Old Northern Road over Halloween period.
4. Tony HAY further mentioned the current traffic congestion problems on Pennant

Street, Castle Hill. Negotiations are ongoing with the RTA as to how to address this issue.

5. Alan CADMAN raised the idea of early closing times for licensed premises across The Hills LAC (2am). Current closing time is 3am. General Discussion held on this topic.
6. Shirley PURSERr raised White Ribbon Day which is occurring nation-wide on the 25/11/2010 with an aim of changing attitudes and behaviours that support or excuse violence against women in Australia. Stalls to be set up in local shopping centres on this date. Domestic Violence Officers from Castle Hill will attend a number of these stalls on the day if their schedules permit.
