  - Pro active team increased to 14-16 staff members

- Meeting targets as per our Business Plan
- Crime stats/categories discussed with CSPC members
  - Crime reduced maintaining good efforts reducing crime
  - Targets met achieving targets
  - Break and enter offences in Strathfield area, would like to see improvement.
  - Car parks in Strathfield area hasn't been a problem compared to last year
  - Overall good results, in relation to serious crime
  - HVP patrolling of Strathfield area, council area.
  - Security audits to be carried out by CPO on commercial businesses
  - Good arrests on break and enter offenders in Silverwater, due to local operations
  - Steal from motor vehicle offences occurring, registration plates getting stolen, increased number of fail to pay incidents
  - New Years Eve tasking's last year very successful, will continue with same effort this year
  - Also working closely with AFP and representatives from Muslim community to further improve New Years Eve celebrations
  - Industrial issues not effecting police roles in Flemington LAC
  - Good arrests break and enter offenders Berala
  - Two major event coming up Stero Sonic 26<sup>th</sup> Nov and V8s 2-3 Dec Cold Chisel
