person unknown for anti-social behaviour.

3. Mr Allen reported that there had been considerable damage (\$20,000+) occasioned to Bernie Mullane Reserve, security had been placed on site but this would be reduced over the next few weeks. He also stated that the incidents of damage at the Balcombe Heights reserve had reduced since they had increased security patrols there.
4. Mayor Bolitho indicated that there had been an increase of empty alcohol bottles/cans etc located at Bruce Perser Reserve.
