Acting Commander MURRAY discussed how police taskings have been guided by the information gleaned from previous meetings regarding hot spots for anti-social behaviour, malicious damage and drug use etc.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Information received from Gordon ALLEN that there has been an increase in anti-social behaviour at Balcombe Heights reserve in the past few months. Security patrols are to be increased on Friday and Saturday nights. The council is currently costing and upgrade to the lighting in the reserve. 2. Mayor BOLITHO rose that there had been an application for the construction of a skate park in Kellyville on Wrights Road. Progress of the application was not yet known. 				

3. Bashir SUMAR raised that he had attended an interfaith meeting recently where economic discussions were held and advice was given as to how different faiths view financial crisis. Suggestion on how each faith deals with financial strain were offered and SUMAR reported that this was beneficial to the community attendees.
