#### Local Crime Type Priorities

*Overview of statistical data for Bogan Shire Council in comparison with other Darling River LAC LGA's. Per capita low crime rate which is an indication of Police presence in the community.*

#### Discussion Item

*Overview of Community Safety Precinct Committee meetings and how they will be run. CPSC's will be chaired by either Local Area Commander or delegated Duty Officer, Minutes made available through NSW Police website. Not a forum to talk about individual issues. CPSC's will be held quarterly.*

*Introduction of Darling River Local Area Commands Crime Prevention Officer (CPO) Senior Constable Debbie Moore. Overview on her role to assist the Community and help implement strategies to reduce crime.*

*Problem re Youth in town not having anything to do and getting into trouble. Stand over tactics do not work on Youths.*

*Drop in centre for Nyngan Discussed. Bogan Shire Council are currently in negotiations re the use of the old Fire Station building.*

*Licensed Premises business hours are controlled by Officer of Liquor, Gaming and Racing, with each licence having specific conditions attached to licence. Sgt Michael Williams is the Licensing Sergeant for Darling River LAC and has extensive knowledge in this area. All breaches of license conditions are subject to a \$1'100 fine. If minors are obtaining alcohol via an adult, this is classed as Secondary Supply.*

*Availability of Police discussed, if phone comes through to Bourke does not mean the Police are not working.*

*Need to talk about proactive crime not just reactive via the media.*

*Have units within Darling River LAC that can be deployed anywhere in the Command these include Target Action Group, Youth Liaison Officer, Crime Prevention Officer, Bike Unit.*

*Police still require information from the Community re illegal drugs and supply.*

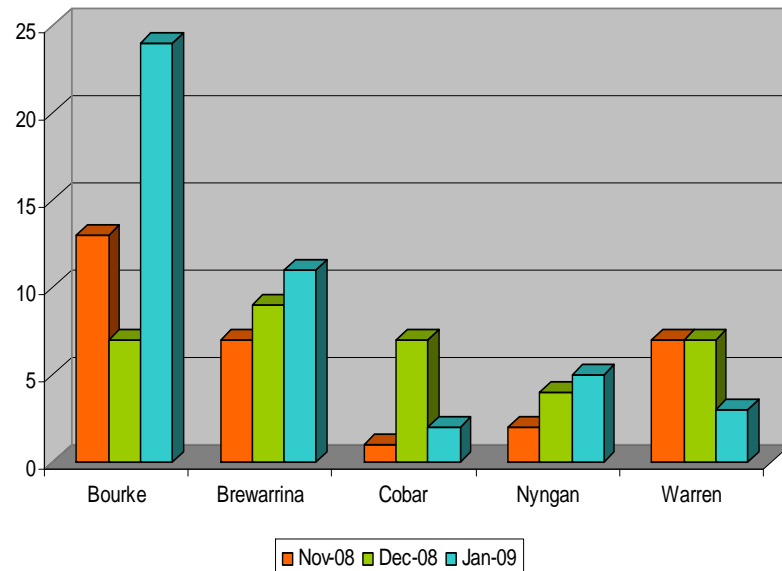
Upgrade of the cells at Nyngan, the works have been approved, but, awaiting funding from the Government to carry out the works.
