Opening and Welcome.

The meeting was opened at 6.40pm by **Debbie Hutchens**, who thanked all present for attending.

Amendments and acceptance of previous meetings.

Matters Arising:

Concerns re the increase in graffiti in the Roseville Area particularly the east side car park and shopping area of Clanville Ave.

Community Police Briefing – Local Crime Priorities

Senior Constable Rollinson- Presented and discussed crime maps re break and enter and malicious damage. Concerns re graffiti in Roseville were discussed in relation to statistics recorded on the maps.

Inspector Bell – provided the group with a further discussion on crime numbers, highlighting variance in recorded crime over different periods, as well as discussing the progress of various crime stats against the Local Area Command's predictive targets.

The group was also provided with a summary of recent notable arrests.

- Arrest of a break and enter offender on 24th October 2010. The offender was responsible for a dramatic increase in break and enters over a short period of time where the offender had been climbing down pipes etc to gain entry to second storey windows and balconies.
- Arrest of break and enter offender 10th November 2010. The offender was located and arrested in Lindfield.
- The result of these arrests has been a dramatic reduction in break and enter offences.
- 9th December 2010 a well known person within the North Shore was arrested after committing an armed robbery at Artarmon Railway Station.

Community Issues / Outcome

<p>Ian St Vincent discussed an incident at Lindfield Primary School on 19th November 2010 where 20 – 25 young people were located within the school grounds causing trouble. Matter has been reported with further discussion between Ian St Vincent and Insp Kent. There has also been an incident where a person was caught dumping rubbish on school grounds. That matter has been investigated and the offender spoken to by police.</p>	<p>Insp Bell advised that at the last supervisors meeting it was discussed that school inspections were being conducted and not recorded. Supervisors are now ensuring that events be created.</p> <p>Senior Constable Rollinson advised that taskings have been created to direct cars to patrol the area Friday nights.</p>
<p>Reg Miu Please define the meaning of a safety camera such as the one of Victoria Ave Balmain?</p>	<p>Ian St Vincent explained that it is a red light camera as well as a speed camera and that it can detect both offences simultaneously. At this time there are none in the North Shore area however there are plans to install a safety camera on Pacific Hwy at Mowbray Rd, Chatswood February 2011 and all cameras in NSW to be converted by May 2012.</p>
<p>Concerns were raised over plans to close Hill St Roseville at Boundary Street to allow changes to the railway bridge allowing higher trucks to travel on Boundary St. This would mean that there would only be two exits from the Roseville shop area. Why cant the area be improved not closed?</p>	<p>Inspector Bell If that were to occur there should be community consultation about it.</p> <p>Ian St Vincent It is true that this will happen. It is to allow for construction of another lane east bound on Boundary St for north bound traffic from the Pacific Hwy. It will be a 3 stage approach. 1)widen state rail bridge 2) widen Boundary St 3) closure of Hill St as the approach will now be too steep. Further enquiries and concerns can be raised with Kuring – Gai Council</p>

PAL is for reporting matters where the offender is unknown such as malicious damage and break and enters and if the matter is out of the realm of PAL they will transfer the call to the relevant agency. Crime Stoppers is for unusual things you see or hear about etc.</p>
