Opening and Welcome.

The meeting was opened at 6.35pm by **Supt Dalton**, who thanked all present for attending.

Amendments and acceptance of previous meetings.

There were no amendments to the previous minutes.

Matters Arising:

Lorraine Lusby – referred to the issue raised by Bob Marsh in the previous minutes in relation to the 40 km/h zone around St Ignatius College.

Inspector Ian Bell – informed the group that the matter had been referred to the Traffic Sergeant and that all traffic was to adhere to the permanent 40km/h zone along the road.

Ian St Vincent – informed the group that the school zone signs were there to control traffic in the area throughout the day.

Ian Bell – mentioned that the area has been a 40km/h zone since 1996.

Superintendent Dalton – informed the group that arrangements were underway to place ‘Angel Rings’ up and down the coast to assist rock fisherman.

Reg Miu – raised the issue of inadequate signage in language people understand.

Community Police Briefing – Local Crime Priorities

Inspector Bell – provided the group with a further discussion on crime numbers, highlighting variance in recorded crime over different periods, as well as discussing the progress of various crime stats against the Local Area Command’s predictive targets.

The group was also provided with a summary of recent notable arrests.

- A 45 year old male was arrested for 2 Indecent Assaults on school girls at Lindfield and Roseville. 15 further offences have been identified and are being investigated by Detectives.
- A 17 year old young person from Forestville was arrested for Malicious Wounding of a 19 year old male at a party at Castle Cove in late July. The young person was arrested 30 minutes after the offence was committed and a knife was located in an industrial bin close to where the incident occurred.
- A 21 year old male from Naremburn and a 23 year old male from Artarmon were charged with 2 Armed Robbery offences at the 7/11 store in Hampden Road, Artarmon on the 12 July 2010.
- Around 2.30am on Sunday the 8 August, patrolling police identified and pursued a stolen vehicle from Naremburn to Willoughby. A motor vehicle collision occurred and a 45 year old male from Liverpool was arrested. He was later charged with several Fraud Offences, Driving Offences and Theft of a Motor Vehicle.
- Two Fingerprint Identifications led to the arrest of two males one from Chipping Norton and another from Warwick Farm for several Steal from Motor Vehicle Offences committed on vehicles in two below ground car parks in unit blocks in Artarmon.

Reg Miu raised the issue about the member of Parliament who refused to undergo a roadside Breathalyser Test.	Inspector Bell informed Reg Miu that if a person refused to undergo a roadside Breathalyser Test they would be arrested. He further stated that if a person refused to undertake the Breath Analysis Machine they would be charged with refuse breath test and High Range. Reg Miu wanted to know who calibrated the machine. Inspector Bell informed the group that the machine was calibrated at the start of each 12 hour shift.
Lorraine Lusby congratulated Superintendent Dalton on receiving the Australian Police Medal.	Supt Dalton thanked Lorraine for her kind words.
