1. Apologies.
2. The outstanding actions were discussed from September's minutes.
3. Superintendent Kenny discussed success of White ribbon day breakfast. We raised Approx \$1,000 although the theme was raising awareness of Domestic Violence. Good Auction results also. The 16 days of activism started on 25th of November.

Adam Cryer discussed Redfern's initiative in raising community awareness of Domestic Violence in that area.

Superintendent Kenny also talked about the death and disabilities changes and how Kuring gai LAC handled the industrial action. Advising group that staff did not put any of the community at risk. Staff took some action but that was mainly administrative, Court notices etc rather than tickets. The Parsons report on restructuring recommendations and policing models. Kuring-gai will be business as usual. Staffing doing jobs and tasking to areas that are needed. New recruits of the 500 350 will go to the country areas and 150 to city locations, Kuring-gai to get 2 new recruits.

Reports out on crime categories. Mostly green (good) Malicious damage down however robbery and sexual assault are up but these are still low. Must report all incidents to reflect crime so resources can be placed where needed.

Julia Eagles. Eyewatch has started and the launch is in the new year. At the all areas NHW meeting discussed a report that was sent to all MP's etc about CPTED (crime prevention through environmental design). To implement standards for all DA's. at the DA stage. Hope to get reply by Feb 2012. New E watch starting in St Ives Chase. St Ives shopping a stall for seniors week is planned.

Eyewatch Would like to consider posting on the KU site to meet in Jan or Feb to discuss. Launch and media release (out of sessions). Link in with Westfield Facebook site in closed groups prior to launch, Several issues to be considered including privacy or released information and jeopardising court cases (to be discussed out of meeting).

Nick Milton discussed article in Advocate. Have met with Deb Birmingham re: traffic for the Christmas period and possible effects on local traffic. Looking to RTA to change Traffic light phasing when needed. Will be working with the RTA re: this. We can't predict adverse situations (weather, crashes) which impact on traffic. Looking at peak times increase phasing and looking for support from Kuring gai LAC in escalating to RTA.

Peter Wilkinson Surveying community for their views on safety in the community. Superintendent Kenny adds Kuring gai did surveys at Hornsby and St Ives and these can be made available.

Danny Houseas adds Kuring-gai Council has done surveys in the past these are available also what come out of these is that some have a lower level of tolerance for crime that others in other areas. Superintendent Kenny CDAT is successful in this area and has approval of other committees.

Peter Kirkwood PCYC Formal commission of the new activity centre (George Street) by MP Matt Kean Phillip Ruddock and Nick Berman. All going good for PCYC.

Superintendent Kenny I was in Goulburn for 3 weeks attending to training duties for new Duty Offices. Still maintained the role of LAC while there.

Senior Constable Paul Cleary Thanks for the support of this committee reminding the importance of reporting all crime, The information from the public gives us the tools to react and solve crime.
