Importation Ban on Lever Action Shotguns, with a capacity of greater than five shots

The NSW Police Force Firearms Registry is aware that the Commonwealth Government has extended the current ban on the importation of lever action shotguns with a magazine capacity of more than five rounds and lever action shotgun magazines with a capacity of more than five rounds.

The temporary importation ban is intended to be in place until the review of the National Firearms Agreement is concluded and the agreed outcomes are implemented.

The NSW Government is continuing to consider its position regarding the re-categorisation of the firearm. Our position will be conveyed to the Commonwealth with regards to furthering the discussions and finalisation of the National Firearms Agreement.
