

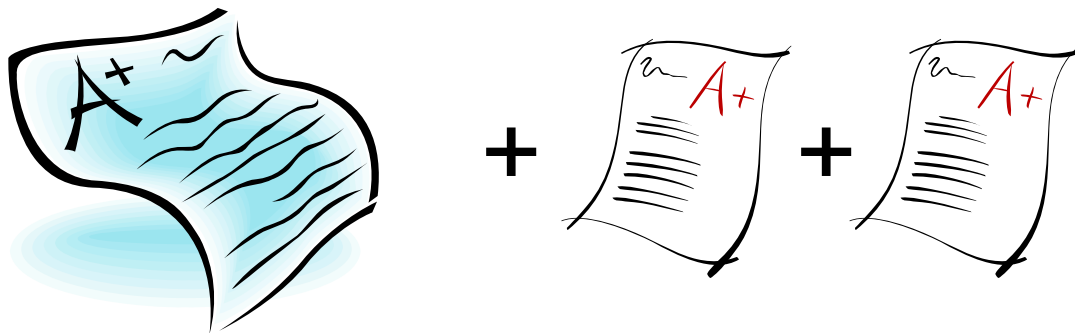
## What's New with Imports?

*The application forms have been changed!*

*We have new forms for making application for a police confirmation and certification for the importation of firearms and weapons into NSW.*

*There is a General Application form for an Individual (and business non-dealer) and a separate General Application form for a NSW firearms dealer.*

*Once the General Application form is completed, the relevant ancillary form for the type of firearm, ammunition or weapon must be completed.*

*Ancillary Form/s*

*The forms are interactive, which means you can complete them online, typing the information in and then print the form before signing and dating it. When your application is complete, you can fax, email or post the forms, and any accompanying documents or photos to the Coordinator Imports, Compliance and Intelligence Unit, Firearms Registry.*

*You may wonder why the application forms require so much information. Well, all that information is required to identify the person making application and for us to be able to adjudicate on the application.*

### *NSW Licensed Firearms Dealers*

*NSW Firearms Dealers making application to import firearms or weapons as stock must enter the item number under Schedule 6 of the Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956 for the article being imported. To assist with identifying this number, there is a Schedule 6 Table available on the Dealers Import page.*

CUSTOMS SCHEDULE 6 ITEM NUMBER	
The following firearms and firearms parts are relevant to an application for a 'Police Certification Test' to the Firearms Registry under a B709 application form. Where requested, please enter the ITEM No on the B709 application & accompanying forms. <a href="#">A link is provided to clause 4F of the Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956.</a>	
CATEGORY A FIREARMS	
Any of the following firearms, other than a firearm: (a) that is: (i) fired, whether by original design or by modification, with a folding or detachable stock; and (ii) capable of being fired when the stock is in the folded position or removed; or (b) that is substantially the same in appearance as a fully automatic firearm.	
Schedule 6 Item No	Description
1	Air rifle Soft air rifle Rumfire rifle, other than a self-loading rumfire rifle Single shot shotgun Double barrel shotgun
1A	An imitation of a firearm mentioned in item 1, other than an imitation that is fired, whether by original design or by modification, with a folding or detachable stock.
