CHECKLIST

All applicants are required to provide:
A completed P638 'Application for a Prohibited Weapon Permit' form.
Proof of Identity (if no other NSW firearms licence or firearms or weapons permit is held or has been held).
Individual applicants - A passport sized colour photo of yourself <u>endorsed and signed</u> on the back by a JP or serving police officer 'This is a true photo of NAME'.
Business Applicants - Business Declaration completed
This Genuine Reason form with the relevant sections completed.
 Quantity, make, name or model and description.
 Evidence that you are a qualified <u>Veterinary practitioner or veterinary student.</u>
OR Evidence that you are employed in an organisation whose primary objective is or includes responsibility for the management of animals.
Oetails of the reason a blow gun or blow pipe are necessary in your occupation.
Oetails of weapon safe keeping facilities.
Safety Training certificate.
Payment of \$127 MUST accompany this application.
Employees - A completed P639 for each person to be authorised by this permit <u>AND</u> proof of identity for each person (<i>if no other NSW firearms licence or permit is held or has been held</i>) <u>AND</u> Safety Training Certificate <u>AND</u> payment of \$25 per person.
