 - O Details of the types of weapons to be displayed and sold at the Arms Fair
 - O Details of the safe keeping of weapons both while on display and in storage after operating hours
 - <u>Payment of \$127 MUST accompany this application</u>

<u>Employees</u> - Application and payment by employees is only applicable where the employee <u>is not</u> currently listed on the PW Dealer or Theatrical Armourer permit of the Arms Fair applicant. Where employees are currently listed on and authorised by on the PW Dealer or Theatrical Armourer permit, submit the names of employees to be listed on the PW Arms Fair permit.

NOTE: A completed P639 <u>AND</u> payment of \$25 per person is required for each employee who <u>is not</u> currently listed on and authorised by the PW Dealer or Theatrical Armourer permit if the employee is required to be authorised by this permit to assist the weapons dealer or theatrical armourer at the Arms Fair.

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
