Disclosure of Information - Pistol Club

Clause 101(d) of the Firearms Regulation 2017

ABN 43 408 613 180

Clause 101(d) of the *Firearms Regulation 2017* prescribes a condition on a Pistol Club Approval that the secretary or other relevant office holder of an approved pistol club must notify the Commissioner if, in their opinion, a person who is a member of the club or who has applied for membership of the club, may pose a threat to public safety or a threat to the person's own safety, if in possession of a firearm.

Section 79A of the *Firearms Act 1996* provides protection from criminal or civil liability to the pistol club or collectors' society or club or the secretary or other relevant office holder of the club or society where the information is provided in good faith.

This form is used for the purposes of the Club Secretary or other relevant office holder notifying the Commissioner under the provisions of clause 101(d) of the *Firearms Regulation 2017*.
