## **Aquatic Rescue Sequence Instructions**

#### **Instructions to Applicant**

- Download the NSW Police Force 'Aquatic Rescue Sequence' information pack.
- Book an appointment with an AUSTSWIM accredited centre. Go to <a href="www.austswim.com.au">www.austswim.com.au</a>
  and search for your nearest centre by following the 'Find a swim centre' link. Select the 'NSWPF Applicant' check box and type in your post code to find a centre near you.
- On the day of the test you will need to present your drivers license or other photo I.D, a
  printed copy of these instructions and a blank 'Certificate of Aquatic Rescue Sequence'
  form to be filled out by the assessor. You must provide a form of photo identification to the
  AUSTSWIM assessor or the assessment will not take place.
- You will also need a pair of light weight pants and a short sleeve shirt for the test.
- Attend the swim centre on time and pay the \$10.00 test fee. Payment of the \$10 fee covers pool entry, assessment and certification, and entitles the applicant to one (1) attempt only. Further attempts at assessment will require payment of an additional fee.
- Undertake the test.
- Upon successful completion of the test forward the completed certificate to the Recruitment Branch along with your Professional Suitability Application and other required documents.

### **Instructions to AUSTSWIM Swimming Teacher**

- Certify the applicant's identity by sighting the drivers licence or other photo I.D and record details on the certificate.
- Collect \$10.00 test fee.
- Ensure applicant has appropriate clothing for the test.
- Complete the 'Aquatic Rescue Sequence' test (see test guidelines)
- Upon successful completion of the test complete the 'Certificate of Aquatic Rescue Sequence' form including instructor licence number and expiry.
- Return the certificate to the applicant.



## **25 METRE AQUATIC RESCUE SEQUENCE**



#### Instructions:

- 1. Enter the water with safe and appropriate entry (slide in entry for shallow water less than 1.5 metres, or shallow dive for water 1.5 metres or over)
- 2. Float, scull or tread water for one (1) minute with feet off the bottom of pool
- 3. Swim 25 metres with head above water to target area utilising freestyle stroke or survival breaststroke
- 4. Float, scull or tread water for one (1) minute with feet off the bottom of pool
- 5. Duck dive to bottom of pool and retrieve a weighted object (2kg rubber brick or similar) from bottom of pool
- 6. Return tow-weighted object swimming 25 metres utilising either sidestroke or lifesaving backstroke
- 7. Exit water appropriately
- Test must be conducted in a 25 metre swimming pool
- Starting point must be shallowest end of pool with deepest end to be not less than 1.2 metres and no greater that 2.0 metres in depth
- Test subjects must wear long trousers (track pants or similar) and a short sleeve shirt throughout the test
- Test subjects must complete the test continuously without stopping or touching the bottom or sides of the pool
- Weighted object may be a rubber brick or similar of approx 2 kg in weight
