

**1. How many such proposals have you had from March 29, 2020 to January 21, 2021?**

18 proposals were received between 29/3/2020 and 21/1/2021.

**2. How many such proposals have you approved?**

Approval of proposals is not provided by the NSWPF.

The NSWPF has responsibility for assessing and providing advice regarding the security component of the proposal. NSW Health also provides advice. Draft proposals are often amended to comply with provided advice.

Once this process has been completed, proposals are approved by NSW Government. The NSWPF then designate the proposed premises as a quarantine facility.

16 locations were designated as quarantine facilities.

**3. Where have these alternative quarantine facilities been located? How many have been private residences and how many have been different hotel facilities? How many have been in Greater Sydney and how many in regional NSW?**
