NSW Firearms Registry now using SMS notifications

SMS messages are a fast and effective way to convey essential information and can be used to remind people of necessary activities or upcoming events.

The NSW Police Force Firearms Registry recognises the need to communicate important information to firearms licence holders and industry stakeholders in real time, which is why we have introduced SMS notifications to our suite of outreach customer services.

SMS notifications will commence 1 July 2019 and will initially be focussed on customers whose firearms licence is due to expire within 7 days and who have not yet submitted their reapplication. Over time, other customer communications will be done via SMS notification.

If you receive a SMS from NSWFIREARMS that is the Firearms Registry communicating directly with you.
