

## FIREARM PERMIT SAFARI TOUR AUTHORITY AND CONDITIONS

Firearm types which apply: The types of firearms specified on the permit

## **Authority**

This permit authorises the permit holder to possess and use firearms to which a category A and B licence applies for the purposes of conducting organised safari tours in NSW.

The authority conferred by this permit is subject to the *Firearms Act 1996* and the Regulation and all the General Legislative Requirements applicable to a firearm permit holder<sup>1</sup> apply to this permit in addition to the conditions outlined below.

## **Conditions:**

- 1. Firearms authorised by this permit must be stored in compliance with the safe storage requirements prescribed by section 40 of the *Firearms Act 1996*<sup>2</sup>.
- 2. Only firearms to which a category A or B licence applies may be possessed and used for the purposes of this permit.
- 3. The permit holder must maintain current and valid written permission from the land owner of any parcel of land on which the safari tour activities are to be conducted.
- 4. The permit holder must ensure that safari tour participants possessing and using firearms hold the relevant licence or permit for the category of firearm used.
- 5. Only participants authorised to possess and use firearms in one of the following ways may participate in the safari tour:
  - A NSW issued category A or B firearms licence issued for the genuine reason of recreational hunting/vermin control; or
  - The equivalent category of licence or authority from another state or territory; or
  - A NSW issued minor's firearms training permit or equivalent authority from another state or territory; or
  - A NSW issued permit authorising an overseas visitor to participate in organised safari tours; or
  - The equivalent of a safari/hunting participation permit issued and in force in another State or Territory.
