Online Applications - Permit to Acquire (PTA) & Reapplication for a Firearms Licence

The NSW Police Force Firearms Registry, in partnership with Service NSW, is pleased to announce that customers can now apply for a Permit to Acquire (PTA) a firearm and renew their firearms licence online. The online platform in which customers can apply for a PTA and renew their firearms licence is provided by Service NSW.

To utilise our new online services, customers will need a Service NSW Account which is linked to NSW Police. In preparation for our new online services, customers can create an account by visiting Service NSW website at www.service.nsw.gov.au and link their account to NSW Police.

Upon completion of the above steps, customers who hold a firearms licence or permit and wish to acquire a firearm, can do so online.

In addition, customers whose firearms licence is due for renewal will receive a letter from the Firearms Registry 90 days prior to the expiry of their firearms licence. This letter will outline the necessary steps to enable our customers to renew their firearms licence online.

Our aim is to continually improve upon our services by providing our customers with a faster, seamless and an overall more user-friendly experience with the Firearms Registry. The launch of these online services reduces the time taken to post paper-based forms and provides an effective and efficient way customers can apply for a PTA and renew their firearms licence.
