

Terms of Reference Firearms Licence Qualification Course (FLQC)

Purpose of the Consultative Group

To contribute to the comprehensive review, development, and implementation of an updated Firearms Licence Qualification Course (FLQC) that is in alignment with legislative changes, industry standards, and NSW public safety objectives.

Scope of Work

- Review the current FLQCs to identify strengths and opportunities for improvement.
- Establish a framework which provides a strong foundation and direction for the future of firearms training requirements in NSW.
- Examine other comparable training and interstate models for potential best practices.
- Consider the possibility and implications of ASQA accreditation, with a focus on instructor competency.
- Consider specialised or targeted learning outcomes or requirements.
- Prioritise public safety throughout the redesign and implementation phases.
