

Reporting Crime to Local Police

If you prefer to phone or attend your local police station and speak with police you can find the phone number and location of your local police station under the "Government" section of the White Pages or by visiting the **NSW Police Force website** www.police.nsw.gov.au/about_us/regions_local_area_commands. You are able to have a support person, friend or relative with you when you report crime to the police.

- When the crime you are reporting can be taken over the phone by the Police Assistance Line, some police stations may refer you to a phone in the police station which directly contacts the Police Assistance Line (131 444). The Police Assistance Line (131 444) will take your report over the phone.
