



REPORTING CRIME TO LOCAL POLICE

if you prefer to phone or attend your local police station and speak with police, you can find the phone number and location of your local police station by visiting the **NSW Police Force website** https://www.police.nsw.gov.au/about_us/regions_commands_districts/police_station_search. Using this link, you can search for your local police station via entering your suburb, town name or postcode. You are able to have a support person, friend or relative with you when you report crime to the police.

Translating and Interpreter Services are available and can be arranged if you choose to attend your local police station.

Once you have attended the police station to report crime, in certain circumstances, you may be referred to a phone in the police station, which directly contacts the Police Assistance Line (**Ph: 131 444**), who will take your report over the phone.
