<sup>^</sup> The table displays a decrease in both Authorised Police Positions and Police Officer Headcount from 2012 to 2013 for both Police Districts. These losses can be attributed to the formation of the Police Transport Command (PTC), Traffic & Highway Patrol Command (THPC) and a loss of Brief Manager Positions.

All police positions attached to Police Districts or Police Area Commands are flexible resources available to respond to incidents across the district. All local resources are also supplemented by specialist police (highway patrol, major crime squads, covert resources and the like) who are managed centrally but can be deployed across boundaries to meet the changing community needs and respond to changing crime patterns and emerging issues. These factors should preface any analysis or assessment of police resources at a specific location.
