

## Reporting Crime to Local Police - People who are Deaf or hard of hearing, or who have a speech impairment

If you prefer to attend your local police station and speak with police you can find the phone number and location of your local police station under the "Government" section of the White Pages or by visiting the **NSW Police Force website** [www.police.nsw.gov.au/about us/regions local area commands](http://www.police.nsw.gov.au/about_us/regions_local_area_commands). You are able to have a support person, friend or relative with you when you report crime to the police.

The NSW Police Force supports the needs of people who are deaf or hard of hearing, or who have a speech impairment. Ask police to arrange an Auslan interpreter if you require one.
