For people who are Deaf, hard of hearing or
have a speech difficulty.

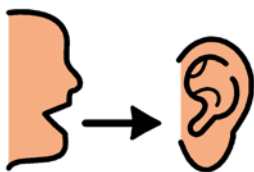
Call Triple Zero **000** with TTY **or** Speak and
Listen. Your call gets answered fast.



TTY users call **106**.

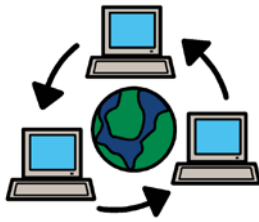
To ask for police type PPP.

TTY users **must** register with the National
Relay Service.



Speak and Listen users call **1800 555 727**.

Ask for Triple Zero **000**.



Internet Relay users call Triple Zero **000** .

This call is **not** a **priority** over other calls. This means we do **not** know you have an emergency.
