Change to Firearms Registry Mailing Address

A review of current business processes employed by the Firearms Registry is currently being undertaken to streamline activities, identify areas for continual improvement and to align practices with the NSWPF strategic corporate model.

One of the activities identified during the review was to centralise the processing of incoming mail. As a result, over the past couple of months a trial has been undertaken to redirect incoming mail to the NSWPF Document Transmission Centre in Parramatta for processing.

Due to the success of this initiative a permanent change to the mailing address for the Firearms Registry is to take effect from 1 November 2019. Please note the physical address and location of the Firearms Registry will not change as part of this initiative.

Firearms Registry resources, including forms, fact sheets, letterhead and other items will be updated with the new mailing address over the coming weeks.

The redirection will remain in place for several months to ensure all incoming mail items using the previous address are received by the Document Transmission Centre.
