AGENDA ITEM 3 – Crime Report by Commander Rogerson

- Crime stats/categories discussed with CSPC members :
 - Robbery offences increase in August
 - Street robberies and armed robbery at local business
 - 3 people charged for serious home invasion
 - Robberies dropped in month of September
 - On average 4-5 robberies per month.
 - Steal from motor vehicles increase
 - Break and enter offences slight increase.
 - Auburn Police performing shoplifting operations approximately once a month
 - On average 10-15 people getting charged with shoplifting offences
 - Shoplifting offences occurring at DFO, Strathfield Plaza, Auburn Central, BWS
 - Assaults down for month of December.
 - Upcoming Dance parties proposed for New Year.
