Update – Gel Ball Blasters

The NSW Police Force wish to advise that previous information regarding the classification of gel ball blasters as an air gun, and therefore, as a Category A firearm remains current.

In addition, if a gel ball blaster substantially duplicates in appearance a military style firearm, they remain categorised as a prohibited firearm.

Further, it is an offence for a person to acquire, supply, possess or use a firearm that is not registered.

The recent not-guilty verdict outcome of R v TOWNER does not change the operation of the *Firearms Act 1996* or its associated regulation and gel blasters remain prohibited for use or possession.
