## When you leave your room:

Have you left any items of value in your room?

If you can't take your valuables with you, secure them.

Valuable documents (including your passport, should you decide not to keep it on you), as well as electronics and jewellery, need to be kept locked up in the hotel/motel room safe or in a hotel/motel safety deposit box.

Do not leave any tempting items visible from outside your room.

Make sure any windows are closed and secured.

Make sure your door is locked, not all doors automatically click shut behind you, so take a second and check the door is locked before you leave.

## When in your room:

Lock your doors and windows, do not leave keys, handbags, wallets or other valuables visible from outside or near entrances.

Lock your vehicle and always remove and take your ignition keys and anything of value each time you leave it.
