Critical incident investigation launched after xx – Cooma

A critical incident investigation has been launched following after an interaction with an elderly woman in the state's south today.

About 4.15am (Wednesday 17 May 2023), emergency services were called to an aged care facility on Binalong Crescent, Cooma, after reports a resident was armed with a knife.

Officers attached to Monaro Police District attended along with NSW Ambulance paramedics and located the woman, still armed with a knife, in a small room.

Police and paramedics attempted to speak to the woman; however, all instructions were ignored.

When she stood up and moved towards officers, a taser was deployed by a xx constable.

The 95-year-old woman was assessed by paramedics and taken to Cooma District Hospital, where she remains in a xx condition.

A critical incident team from xx Police District will now investigate the circumstances surrounding the incident.

That investigation will be subject to independent review.

The officer's employment is under review.
