### Firearms Licensing Requirement

After a Class 1F security licence has been issued, in accordance with conditions imposed under section 23E of the Security Industry Act 1997, licensees will be required to undertake Security Firearms Training. This requires the licensee to apply to the NSW Police Force Firearms Registry for a provisional Category H licence.

### Security Firearms Training

- CPPSEC3114 Control security risk situations using firearms
- This unit in this skill set includes the following prerequisite requirements:*
- CPPSEC3115 Carry, operate and maintain revolvers for security purposes OR
  - CPPSEC3116 Carry, operate and maintain semi-automatic pistols for security purposes
