


SAFE BOATING



PLANNING YOUR TRIP:

- Plan your trip – check your equipment, weather, vessel and boating licence.
- Tell someone where you are planning on boating and when you are expecting to return.
- Only carry as many passengers as are permitted on your boat and ensure there are enough life jackets on board.
- Know your limitations and the limitations of your vessel
- Ensure all mandatory safety equipment is onboard and in good, serviceable condition.

SAFETY ON THE WATER:

- Don't drink and drive – less than 0.50 for recreational vessel operators aged 18 and over and a person supervising a child operator of a motor vessel. People aged under 18 is 0.00.
- Always keep a proper lookout.
- Wear your lifejacket if alone or in poor weather.
- Adhere to speed limits and other navigational signage.
