PREMISE

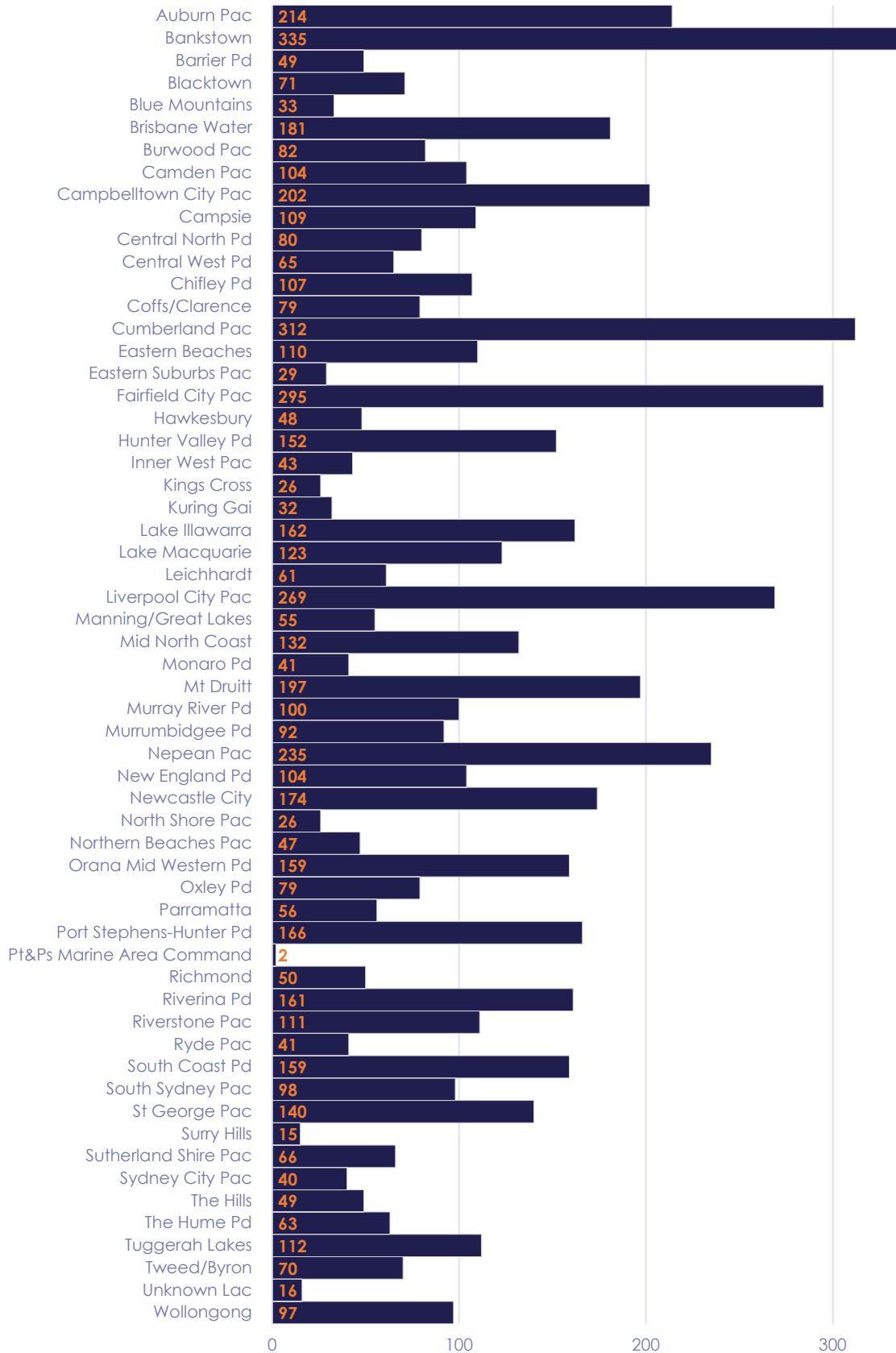

The total number of FPOs and WPOs has decreased slightly since the last disclosure as a result of the removal of historic duplicates.

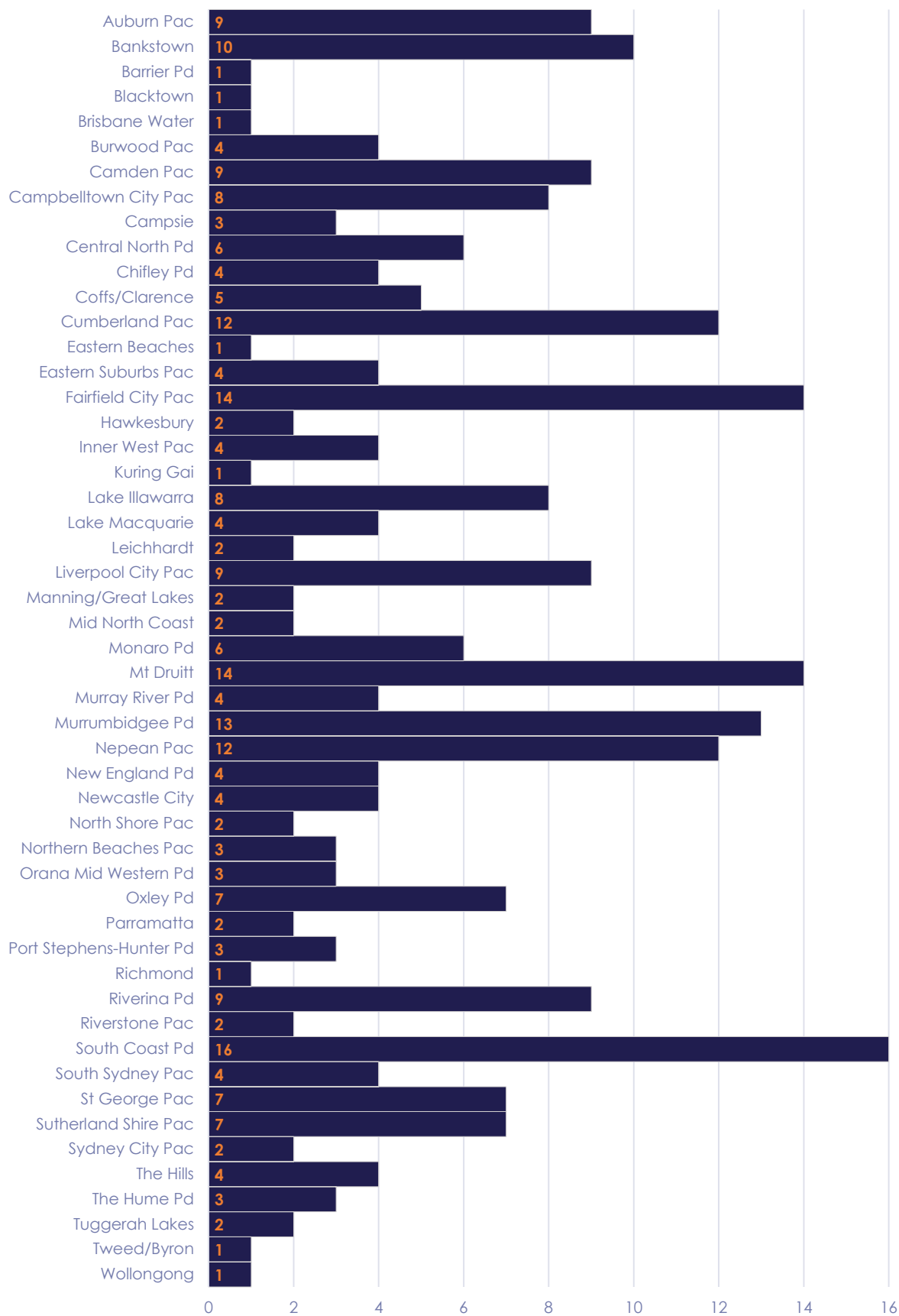


FIREARM PROHIBITION ORDERS

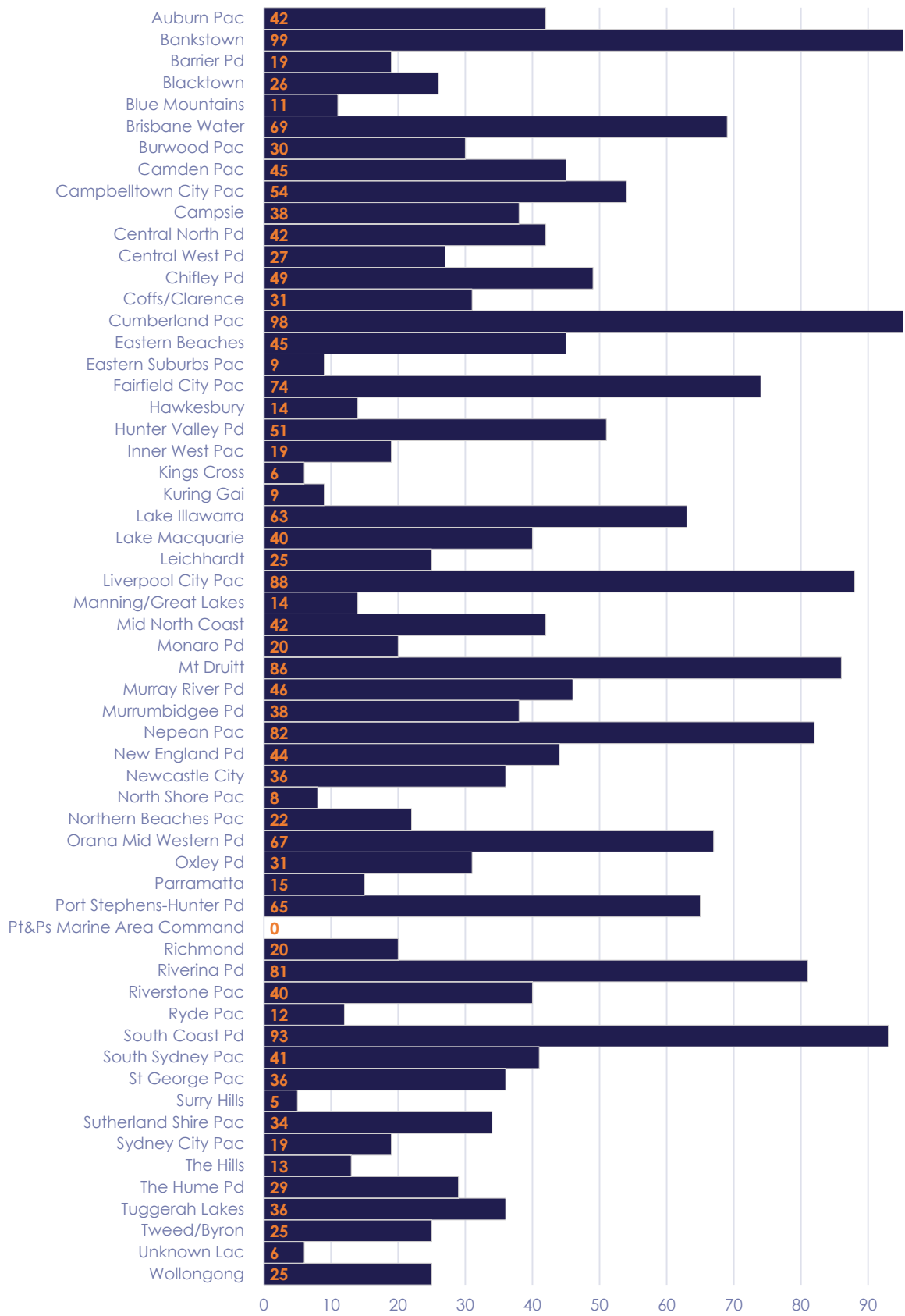
