# INSTRUMENT OF APPROVAL

**FIREARMS REGULATION 2017**

As delegate of the Commissioner of Police, I make this Instrument of Approval in accordance with clause 28B of the Firearms Regulation 2017 and provide that the following be the type approved by the Commissioner:

1. Pursuant to clause 28B(3)(a)(i) of the Firearms Regulation 2017, the locked receptacle for category A and category B firearms must be made of steel or hardwood that is not easily penetrable. For category C, category D and category H firearms, the safe must be a steel safe. These safes are to be commercially manufactured safes designed for securing firearms.
2. Pursuant to clause 28B(3)(b) of the Firearms Regulation 2017, any safe must be fitted with an alarm that is monitored off-site.
3. Pursuant to clause 28B(3)(c) of the Firearms Regulation 2017, the alarm system must reflect the importance of this security measure and be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's requirements. The premise must have a functional intruder alarm and duress facilities with off-site notifications and response, that covers the entire premise and includes internal movement/ motion sensor/s that cover and detect any breach of the premise.

This Instrument of Approval takes effect from the date of signature.
