The Statement of Values are the guiding principles of the NSW Police Force. The Statement of Values remain the central piece of legislation that underpins the conduct of all NSW Police Force employees and how we are judged by the community.

Section 7 of the *Police Act 1990*

Each member of the NSW Police Force is to act in a manner which:

- (a) places integrity above all,
- (b) upholds the rule of law,
- (c) preserves the rights and freedoms of individuals,
- (d) seeks to improve the quality of life by community involvement in policing,
- (e) strives for citizen and police personal satisfaction,
- (f) capitalises on the wealth of human resources,
- (g) makes efficient and economical use of public resources, and
- (h) ensures that authority is exercised responsibly.
